Why Do You Type in Text


- We will delete this text (from previous screen) later but it is to help us find where to place the EMBED code from you tube when we edit the HTML in the page.

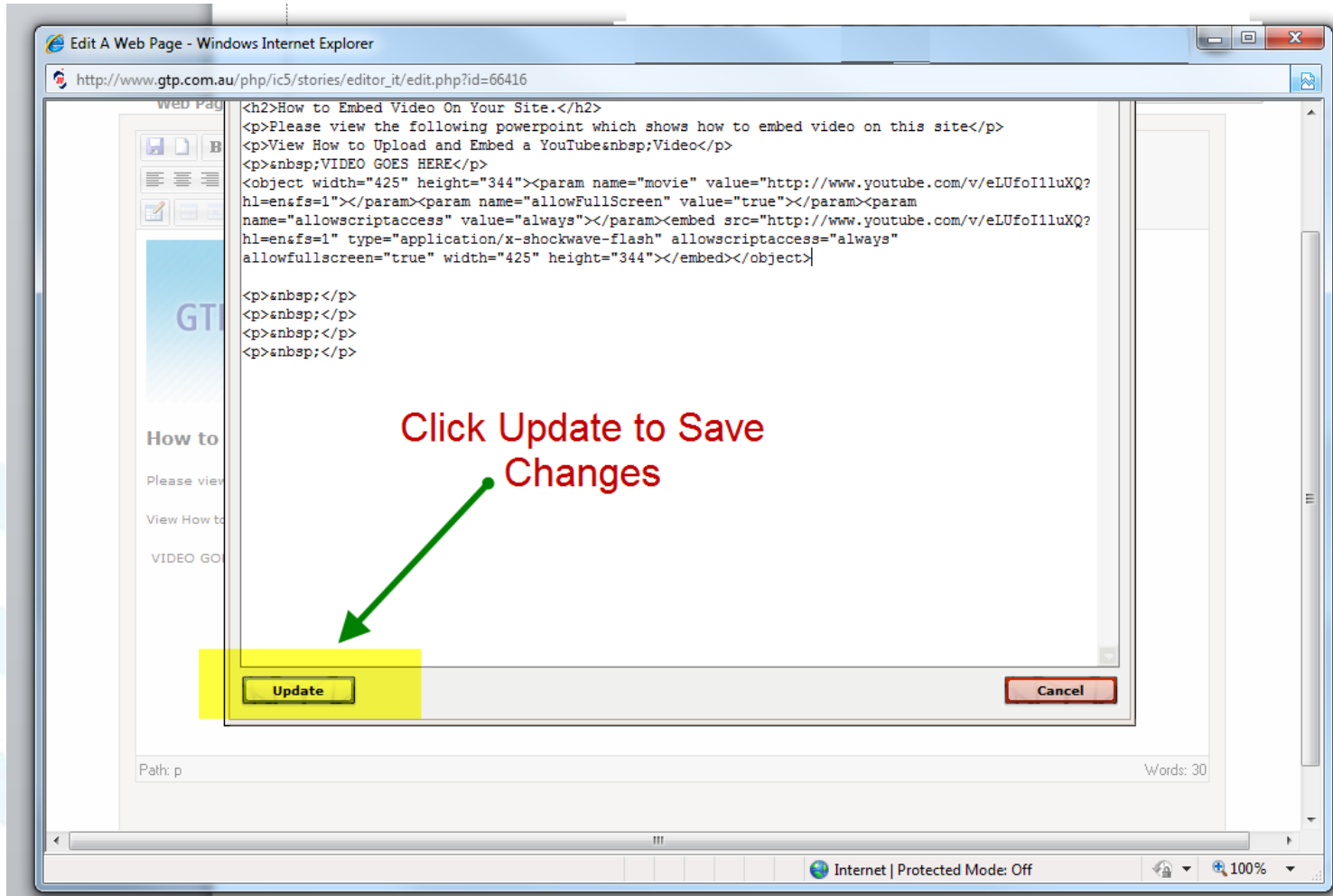

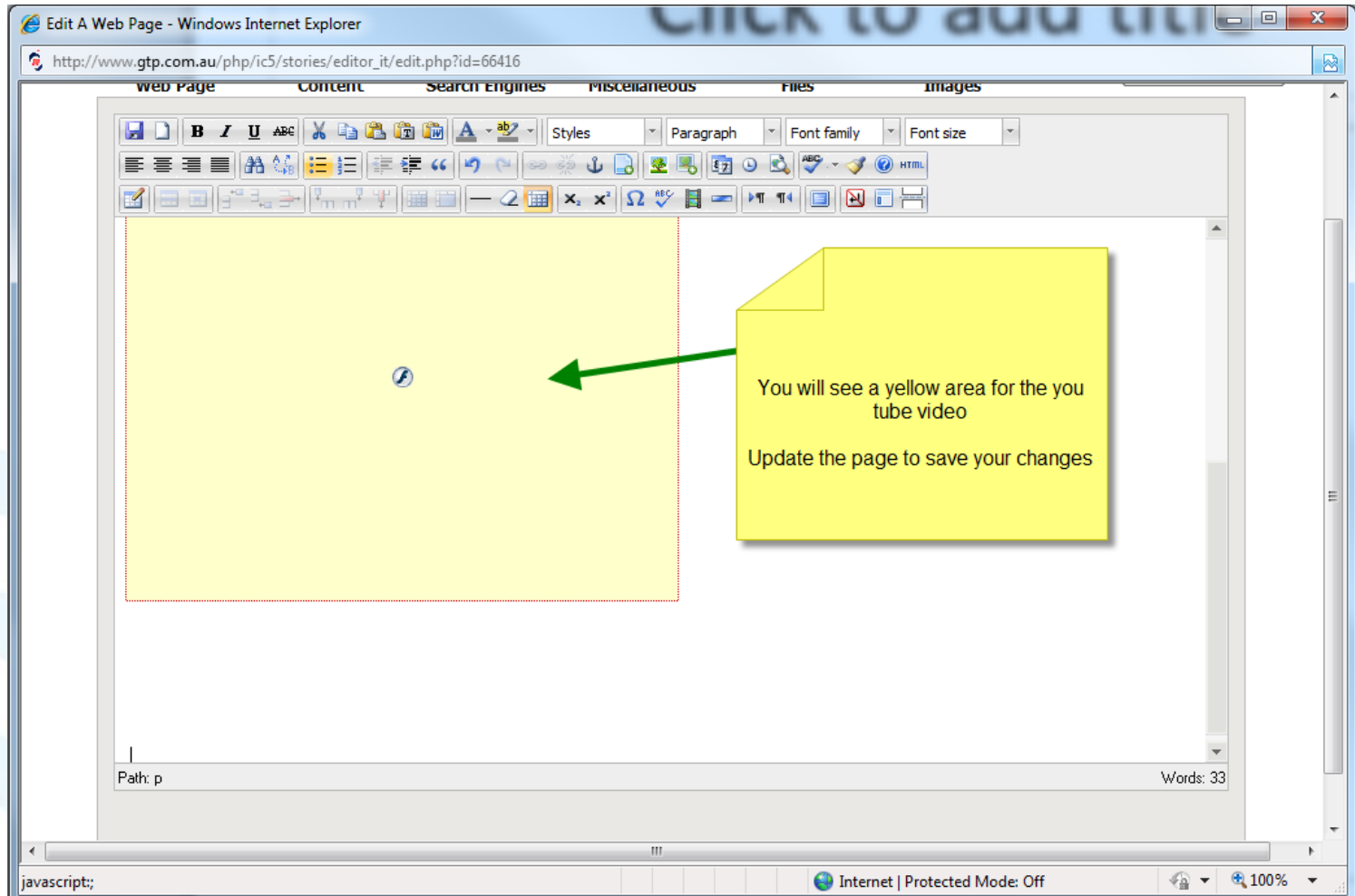


